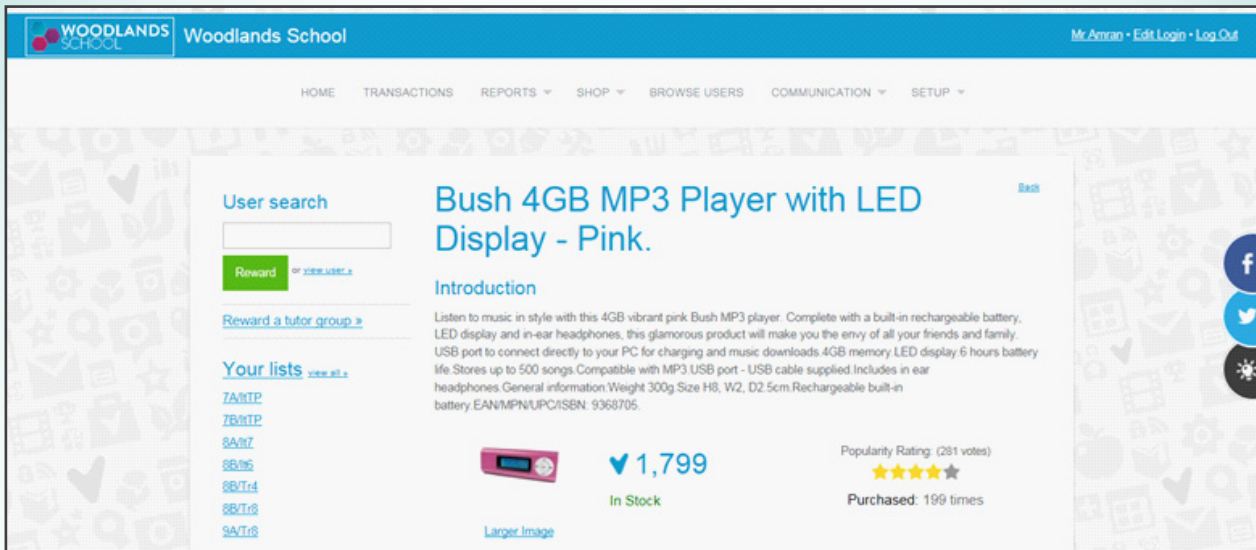


# VIVO MILES

## What have our pupils been doing with their VIVO credits?
