



## Logging in - PIN

Logging in to your Show My Homework account either by PIN or Username and Password means that you can gain access to account specific information, which means a student will be able view their personalised calendar and to do lists as well as being able to submit homework online. These features help students to organise themselves and encourage them to manage their own workload.

Logging in with your PIN is really easy and allows you to set your own password. Once you have been issued your PIN by your school, you simply have to go to your school's Show My Homework web page and enter your PIN into the relevant field.
