Job Title:	Aspirations Ambassador
Responsible to:	SENDCO (DOc)/ Assessment Lead (WRo)
Role:	To represent the Aspirations Faculty during staff interviews, parental events and in all aspects of school life. To support our younger pupils as they settle in to life at Woodlands and act as positive role models that our young people aspire to be. To support our year 6 pupils during the Induction day.
Personal Skills / Qualities:	Good attendance, communication and organisational skills, leadership qualities and the ability to help others. Strong candidates will have the ability to prioritise work.
Applications:	Write a letter to Mr O'Connor explaining why you would like to be an Aspirations Ambassador.
Positions:	15 places for pupils currently in Year 7 to 11.

Responsibilities / Duties

- Represent the Aspirations Faculty at key school events.
 - Give school tours for prospective pupils, parents, and staff.
 - Support younger year groups with reading, literacy, well being and general support.
 - Give their views to adults who work to support SEND.
 - Be a positive role model and advocate for children and young people with SEND.
 - Work with other young people on specific tasks and projects overseen by the Aspirations Faculty.
 - Take part in a pupil panel for interviewing possible new staff.
 - Help out at open evening, parents evening etc.
 - Help Co-Educators deliver clubs/activities.
 - Ensure the Aspirations Classroom is an inviting space for pupils.
 - Mentor younger students.
 - Be part of a Pupil Voice group to give feedback on the school.
